Our hurricane policy is set up with the compassionate care of our patients as our highest priority. A minor storm may prevent our staff from coming in to care for and feed our patients and boarders. A major storm could prevent pet care for days to weeks, which could be fatal to your pet. We monitor each storm carefully and close our hospital accordingly for the safety of the pets and our employees. For that reason, we request a phone number of someone, an emergency contact, who is willing to pick up boarding and hospitalized pets immediately in the event of a storm, which threatens our area. We must have verbal verification from your emergency contact on or before you arrive for your reservation or **WE WILL NOT ALLOW YOUR PET(S) TO BOARD**. If the local authorities advise an evacuation, we will follow the advice of our local emergency management officials and we will close The Cat Practice.

I understand The Cat Practice will make every attempt to reach my emergency contact in the event of a hurricane, but if they are unable to reach my emergency contact my pet will be evacuated with staff members at an additional cost of \$100 evacuation fee and \$75.00 displacement fee per pet. Furthermore, my pet, prior to evacuation, will have an Avid Friendship inserted for permanent identification as needed.

The Cat Practice Veterinary Hospital is not liable for any damages or loss of life resulting from a storm or hurricane.
